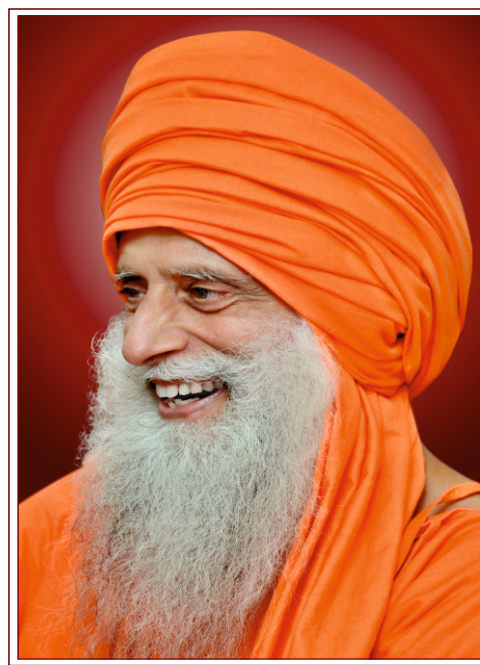

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Inspiration, Genesis and Philosophy

Sri Guru Nanak Dev Ji Maharaj, preached the tenet of universal brotherhood, guided by the mantra 'Love All, Help All, Serve All'. With this philosophy, He founded the unique 'Nirmal Panth' which was formally organized by the 10th Guru Sri Guru Gobind Singh Ji in 1686 AD. Philosophy of 'Nirmal Panth' and its glorious history of 400 years were the key inspirations in founding of Nirmal Ashram at Rishikesh. Sant Buddha Singh Ji Maharaj was the founder and first Spiritual Head (Mahant) of the Nirmal Ashram. He spearheaded the religious and social affairs of the Ashram from 1903 until his ascension to the heavenly abode in 1937. Subsequently, Mahant Atma Singh Ji Maharaj remained Spiritual Head (1937-1973) and Mahant Narain Singh Ji Maharaj (1974-1982). They all selflessly served Nirmal Ashram Trust. Sant Nikka Singh Ji Maharaj 'Virakat' (1894-1983) is one of the most important and revered figureheads in the history of Nirmal Ashram. He was an ascetic, great scholar and preacher of Gurbani. He was deeply devoted to the basic principles of Sri Guru Granth Sahib Ji. With the grace of Almighty and blessings of Sant Nikka Singh Ji Maharaj **H H Mahant Ram Singh Ji Maharaj** became the Spiritual Head of Nirmal Ashram Rishikesh in 1982. He travels worldwide to spread the knowledge of sacred values of Gurbani, Vedas and other Religious Scriptures, thereby rendering selfless services to humanity. **Sriman Sant Jodh Singh Ji Maharaj** (Secretary General) is serving Humanity through all the works of Planning, Development and Administration of Nirmal Ashram and all its institutions.

Activities at Nirmal Ashram

'Love All, Serve All' defines the very ethos of Nirmal Ashram. All the activities of the Ashram proceed with a view to achieve this high aim and ideal. Message of Gurbani and spiritual thoughts continue from early morning till late night through recitation of Gurbani, singing of hymns and Satsang. Sainly and underprivileged persons who come to receive bhiksha (alms) daily in the morning are welcomed with the Aarti and showering of flowers. Then they all are offered food and tea called 'Ann Chhettar'. This way about 700 persons are served daily alongside recitation of Bhajans & Kirtan. All devotees & visitors are provided Guru Ka Langar from morning to night. The Ashram has its own Gaushala at its branch Nirmal Bagh Kankhal, Haridwar. All persons receive milk after dinner. Thereafter a congregation is held in which Gurbani Shabads are recited. Children receiving training for Shabad Kirtan also get a chance to participate in this recitation. Pilgrims visiting the Holy city of Rishikesh and those who are staying at Nirmal Ashram receive the blessings and love of Satguru Maharaj Ji. They also enjoy the natural and spiritual atmosphere of the Ashram. By remaining busy in selfless service and recitation of God's name they enrich their lives. Undoubtedly Sewa and Simran are the foundation pillars of Nirmal Ashram. (0318)
